Care-A-Van

The Johns Hopkins Bayview Medical Center Community Care-A-Van is a free, mobile medical unit staffed by Medical Center health care professionals. Services provided by the Care-A-Van include primary medical care, immunizations, acute care, physicals and education on various health-related topics.

A bilingual English/Spanish-speaking representative always is present on the Care-A-Van. Services are targeted to uninsured children and pregnant women who do not have a regular source of medical care. All services on the van are free of charge. Bring any immunization records for your children being seen. We will also need demographic information on those being seen, including age, a current address, phone number, etc.
